**SUBMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTARY ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION FOR THE
BREEZY HILL ENERGY PROJECT REGARDING ASSESSMENT OF THE INDICATIVE
GRID ROUTE (ECU CASE REFERENCE ECU00005060)**

On behalf of Breezy Hill Energy Limited (Company Registration Number SC720311) please find enclosed Supplementary Environmental Information (SEI) Report documents in relation to the Breezy Hill Energy Project (the 'Proposed Development').

Breezy Hill Energy Limited applied to the Scottish Ministers in May 2025 for Section 36 (S36) consent and deemed planning permission, under the terms of the Electricity Act 1989, for permission to construct and operate the Proposed Development, at a site centred at British National Grid (BNG) 248092, 612583.

The application was supported by an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report as required by The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017 to assess the environmental impacts of the Proposed Development.

Furthermore, in December 2025 an Additional Information (AI) submission was made to Scottish Ministers regarding the changes in the positioning of two Turbines (Turbines 2 and 13) and associated infrastructure.

This SEI is being submitted in response to a request from the Energy Consents Unit (ECU) for further environmental information in relation to the indicative grid connection for the Proposed Development (as currently proposed), and the possibility for cumulative or in-combination effects. It is noted that a separate Section 37 application will be made by the network operator for the grid connection and will be fully assessed at that time. There are no changes proposed to the Proposed Development as part of this SEI.

The submission documents have been uploaded electronically to the Scottish Government's Energy Consents Unit portal and comprises a report document with 15 associated figures, and a Planning Statement Addendum. There are no other accompanying documents or associated confidential appendices.

A printed copy of the SEI AI Report will be made available to view during opening hours at the Dalmellington Community Centre, Dalmellington and at East Ayrshire Council (The Johnnie Walker Bond, 15 Strand Street, Kilmarnock, KA1 1HU) via appointment.

The application will be advertised providing notification of the submission of the SEI as follows:

- The Edinburgh Gazette: 14th July 2026;
- The Cumnock Chronicle: 15th July 2026; and

The closing date for responses will be Friday 14th August 2026 (30 days from date of publication of the last advert).
